



## Alpine View Wodonga

Alpine View Estate aims to successfully integrate new urban development with the natural environment. The Landscape Concept has been developed using the Estate itself as the means of reconnecting damaged biodiversity links. The parks and reserves not only provide places for people, but are also important components in reconnecting habitat. Indigenous Whitebox Grassy Woodland species have been reintroduced to the site and combined with appropriate drought tolerant species.

Water Sensitive Urban Design was incorporated in collaboration with the project engineers. Overland stormwater is diverted to an open watercourse, lined with rock and planted with indigenous riparian species. Boardwalks and viewing platforms are incorporated within the watercourse.

The Landscape Concept integrates social links between Huon Hill, Bandiana Military Camp and the City of Wodonga by providing community parks, play spaces and a network of pedestrian / cyclist trails. Quiet seating areas have been incorporated in the parks, and play areas have been designed to stimulate imagination and encourage exploration of the natural environment.

Sustainable materials have been selected, sourced & installed using local resources wherever possible.
